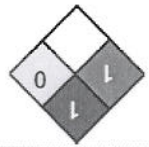

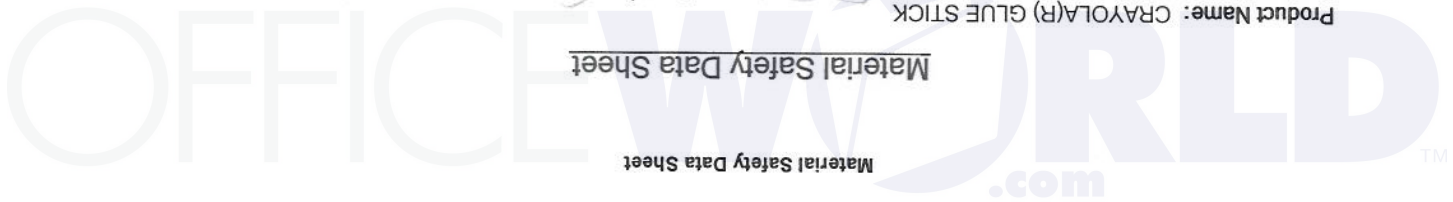

4. First Aid Measures

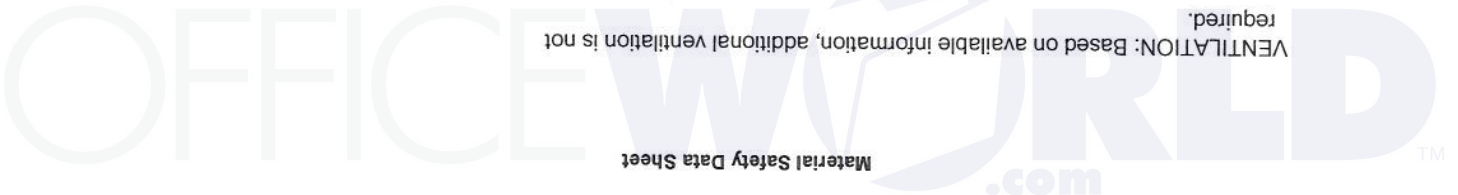

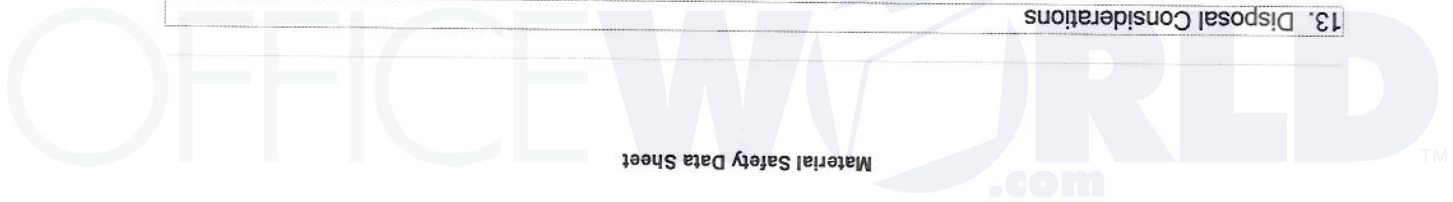
